Endodontic referrals

Our high standards are achieved by: constantly updating our skills and knowledge by attending post graduate courses, through training and development, feedback and audits, vesting in high quality equipment and materials as the technology improves and the use of a CBCT scanner improves diagnosis and treatment planning.



We almost always place a core following endodontic treatment. This ensures that the root canal is sealed on completion as this has an impact on the long-term outcome. Furthermore, placing the core ensures that even if there is a delay in placing the cusp protection, the tooth is not compromised. We will not however provide any final/cusp-protected restoration or any further restorative treatment unless specifically requested by the referring dental practitioners.

We are sensitive to the fact that many general dental practitioners are capable of carrying out more advanced dentistry to a high standard.

A referral to our practice for endodontic treatment will result in the patient only having that treatment undertaken and we will hand the patient back to the referring practitioner for final restoration.

We often go through great length to explain the difficulties and the complexities of endodontic treatment to the patients that have been referred and this often helps to settle potential disputes and misunderstandings between the referring dentist and patient.

Services:

- ✓ Diagnosis - sometimes the diagnosis is not straight forward.
- ✓ Endodontic treatment of teeth with complex anatomy, for example sclerosed canals and curved root canals.
 - ✓ By-passing ledges or obstructions.
- ✓ Re-treatment of failed root canal treatments.
 - ✓ Fractured instrument retrieval.
 - ✓ Post removal.
 - ✓ Perforation repair.
- ✓ Assessing restorability of teeth.
 - ✓ Trauma cases.

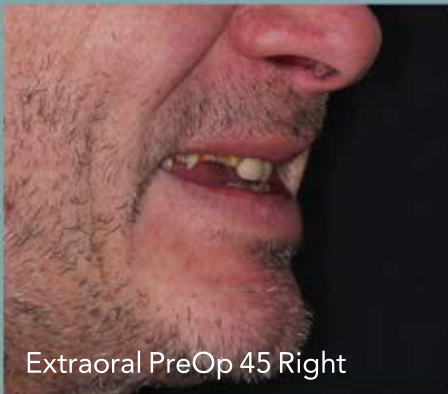

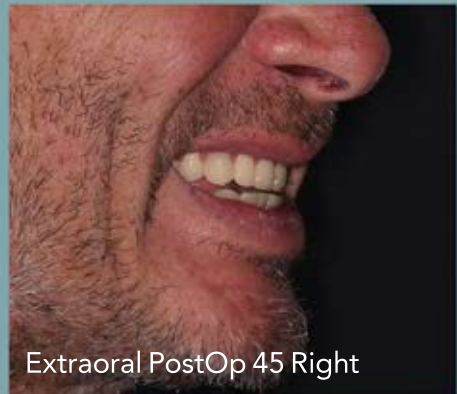
Case study 1

A 50-year-old male presented with difficulty eating and concerns about his appearance. He was motivated but had a limited budget.

Clinical examination showed severe tooth wear spanning from second premolar to second premolar, accompanied by a reduced vertical dimension. A shortened arch approach with mutually protected occlusion was adopted, with the aim of encouraging posterior eruption through the Dahl effect.

Frontal Review

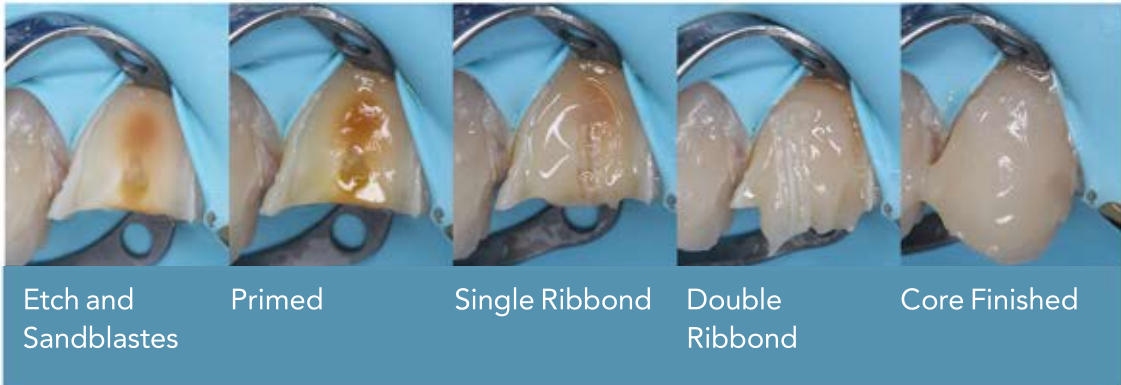
Treatment provided by Ignacio Farga Niños:

Lower arch: Injectable composite restorations within second premolars.

Upper arch: Crown restorations in polished PICN multicolour to reduce lab cost.

Stabilisation splint: Delivered to protect the restorations.

Core build-ups of all upper teeth were carried out under strict rubber dam isolation. The procedure followed an evidence-based protocol for bonding to sclerotic dentin, including 47 μm aluminium oxide sandblasting and the application of a 4th generation adhesive system (OptiBond FL). A nanohybrid composite reinforced with a double mesh of ultra-high molecular weight polyethylene (UHMWPE) fibres was used to enhance mechanical strength.



Case study 2

An 80-year-old male patient presented with functional and aesthetic concerns related to severe generalised tooth wear and multiple missing teeth. Following a comprehensive assessment, a full mouth rehabilitation was carried out over the course of one year, aiming to restore long-term function and natural aesthetics with minimal maintenance requirements.



Treatment provided by Ignacio Farga Niñosles:

The treatment plan involved a combination of indirect restorations including: crowns, onlays, and veneers in conjunction with removable partial dentures to replace missing posterior support and maintain occlusal stability. All adhesive preparations and cementation procedures were performed under full rubber dam isolation, following a gold standard protocol to ensure optimal bonding conditions and long-term clinical success.

At the completion of restorative treatment, a maxillary stabilisation splint was provided to protect the restorations and remaining dentition from potential parafunctional forces and to minimise the risk of future wear. At the 18-month review, restorations and prostheses remained stable, with excellent function and satisfactory aesthetics.
